The process in the past

Indicators manually extracted from different sources.

Copied and pasted in Excel tables

Copied and pasted in inDesign by designers

Each step can introduce errors!

Hard to track mistakes

The role of SDMX

- SDMX Registry
 - Always up-to-date
 - Authoritative
 - Single source of truth for data

SOWC is only one of many many possible output formats.



The process now

- A configuration file maps the API call to the column in the report
- The data is pulled from the SDMX APIs
- The output is already in PDF format, no designers involved

Fully automated → reduces manual work and errors

Summary

- One source of truth: SDMX registry
- COPE principle: Create once, publish everywhere
- Automation: Reduces errors, improves reproducibility
- Efficiency: From data to publication in one click
- Reusability: We can reuse the process for other reports
- Multilinguality: Easy to output multiple languages
